Dalton, December 1, 1930.

Less also, that certain piece, parcel or tract of land in Greenville Township, county and state aforesaid heretofore conveyed by R.K. Taylor, Jr. Committee for R.K. Taylor to Herman F. Dill, Sr. and Herman F. Dill, Jr. by deed of June 24, 1965 recorded in Vol. 776 page 464 and having according to the plat of Terry T. Dill, December, 1964 the following metes and bounds: Beginning at an iron pin at the edge of Pendleton Road and running thence S. 26-30 W. with property of Herman F. Dill, Sr. 168.6 feet to a pin; thence N. 89 - 07 E. 51.7 feet to a pin; thence N. 0 - 53 E. 153 feet to the beginning corner, including in said property a strip of land subject to an easement for a railroad right-of-way.
