Ragsdale, in the State aforesaid, the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged have granted, bargained, sold and released and by these presents do grant, bargain, sell and release unto the said J.C. Ragsdale, a certain piece or parcel of land situated, lying and being in the County of Greenville, S.C., Cleveland Township on the waters of the Middle Saluda River- metes and bounds to wit:

Beginning at a stone Paysoux Line; thence 40 E. 11.16 to an iron pin, Paysoux corner; thence S. 50° W. 6.59 to an iron pin on south side of Headforemost Creek; thence South 75° E. 2.96 to corner at mouth of Ditch; thence N. 42° E. 4.67 to head of Ditch; thence N. 25° E. 3.84 to old chimney place on ridge; thence N. 21° W. 2.76 to black gum; thence N. 42° W. 1.25 to Beech tree; thence N. 31° W. 1.25 to white oak; thence N. 33° W. 1.14 to poplar; thence W. to the beginning, containing 7.62 acres, more or less, adjoining lands of C.G.
