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or could do in my own proper person if personally present, the above specifically enumerated powers being in aid and exemplification of the full, complete and general power herein granted and not in limitation or definition thereof and I hereby ratify and confirm and promise at all times to ratify and confirm all and whatsoever my attorney shall lawfully do or cause to be done in and about the premises by virtue of these presents, including anything which shall be done between the revocation of these presents by my death or in any other manner and notice of such revocation reaching my attorney; and I hereby declare that as against me and all persons claiming under me everything which my attorney shall do or cause to be done in pursuance hereof after such revocation as aforesaid shall be valid and effectual in favor of any person claiming the benefit thereof who before the doing whereof shall not have had notice of such revocation.

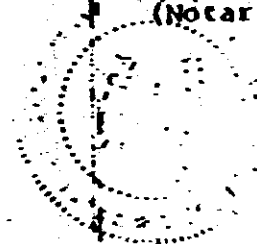
