The affidavit of Michael Arms, Deputy of Civil Division of Sheriff's Department, Greenville County, South Carolina, indicates that he was unable to find the Respondent and an Order of Publication was issued by Rachel W. Tolly, Clerk of Court for Greenville County, on ~~June~~ ^{July} 7th, 1976.

It appears from the publisher's certificate of The Greer Citizen that publication of the Rule to Show Cause was made on July 7, 14, and 21, 1976.

On July 26, 1976 at 10:00 o'clock a.m. Respondent herein failed to appear either in the Courtroom or at chambers in the Court of Common Pleas for Greenville County as ordered. Attorney for Petitioner, S. Gray Walsh, did appear on behalf of Petitioner.

No appearance having been entered by Respondent, it is the Order and Decree of this Court that the R. M. C. Office for Greenville County mark that certain mortgage recorded in Mortgage Book 783 at Page 572 in said office, from Jesse Thomas Cox to William L. Costner paid and satisfied in full, the authorization for said action being this Order and Decree of this Court. This Order and Decree is made pursuant to Section 45-68 through 73 of the 1962 Code of Laws of South Carolina, as amended.
