"All that certain piece, parcel or lot of land, with all improvements thereon, or hereafter constructed thereon, situate, lying and being in the State of South Carolina, County of Greenville, being known and designated as .70 acres according to plat of the property of F. H. Brookshire, recordedin Plat Book UU at Page 173, in the RMC office for Greenville County, and having according to said plat the following — Estes and bounds:

BEGINNING at an iron pin on the southern side of Carolina Drive, at the joint front corner of lot \$ 18, and running thence with the line of lot # 18, S. 5-04 W. 301.6 feet to iron pin; thence S. 85-00 E. 100 feet to iron pin, joint rear corner of other property of F.
