I find that the allegations contained in the verified

Petition are true and correct and it appears to the court that
the relief which is sought by the Petitioners is meritorious and
should be granted. Now, therefore, upon motion of Dillard,
Mitchell & Ariail, Attorneys for the Petitioners, the Respondents
being in default,

IT IS ORDERED, ADJUDGED AND DECREED that the real estate mortgage recorded in the RMC Office for Greenville County, South Carolina, in Mortgage Book 572 at page 319, given by Albert D. Woods and Lylette E. Woods to Eugenia S. Southerland, in the original sum of \$1,450.00, should be cancelled and satisfied of record.

IT IS PURTHER ORDERED, ADJUDGED AND DECREED, that the Register of Mesne Conveyances for Greenville County, South Carolina, enter upon the proper indices in the public records of her office the satisfaction and cancellation of said mortgage of record immediately.
