THIS MORTGAGE is made this 26th day of April 1979, between the Mortgagor, Troy Plumley (herein "Borrower"), and the Mortgagee, Family Federal Savings & Loan Association (herein "Lender"), a corporation organized and existing under the laws of the United States of America, whose address is 713 Wade Hampton Blvd., Greer, South Carolina (herein "Lender").

WHEREAS, Borrower is indebted to Lender in the principal sum of THIRTEEN THOUSAND, FIVE HUNDRED AND NO/100ths Dollars, which indebtedness is evidenced by Borrower's note dated April 26, 1979 (herein "Note"), providing for monthly installments of principal and interest, with the balance of the indebtedness, if not sooner paid, due and payable on May 1, 1989.

C. Highway Number 116 and being more specifically described in a deed recorded in Deed Book 1052 at page 58 on March 30, 1977 in the RMC Office for Greenville County.
