

SCHEDULE A

All that certain piece, parcel or lot of land situate, lying and being in the County of Greenville, State of South Carolina, on the Southeastern side of Lindberg Avenue, being known and designated as Lot 6, as shown on plat of Property of Ladson A. Mills, which plat is of record in the RMC Office for Greenville County in Plat Book H, Pages 117 & 118, reference to said plat being craved for a notes and bounds description thereof.

All that certain piece, parcel or lot of land situate, lying and being in the City and County of Greenville, State of South Carolina, at the southeastern corner of intersection of South Leach Street and Esther Street (formerly Moore's Alley) and being known as Lots 1, 2, 3 and 4 on plat by E. H. McCullough and having, according to a more recent survey prepared for Emma E. Sullivan Estate by W. J. Riddle, dated June 2, 1937, the following notes and bounds, to wit:

BEGINNING at an iron pin at the southeastern corner of the intersection of South Leach Street and Esther Street, and running thence along the eastern side of South Leach Street S. 18-00 W. 64 feet, more or less, to an iron pin at the corner of property now or formerly owned by Stow; thence along the line of said Stow property, S. 76-00 E. 100 feet to an iron pin; thence S. 15-00 W. 50 feet to an iron pin; thence S. 76-00 E. 103 feet to a point in the center of a 10-foot alley; thence along the center of said alley, N. 18 E. 100 feet to a point in the center of said alley on the southern side of Esther Street; 202 feet to an iron pin, the point of beginning.
