To All Whom These Presents May Concern:

THOMAS E. TRIBBLE

(hereinafter referred to as Mortgagor) (SEND(S) GREETINGS:

WHEREAS, the Mortgagor is well and truly indebted unto FIRST FEDERAL SAVINGS AND LOAN ASSOCIATION OF GREENVILLE, SOUTH CAROLINA (hereinafter referred to as Mortgagee) in the full and just sum of

TWELVE THOUSAND FIVE HUNDRED AND NO/100 ----- (\$ 12,500.00)

Dollars, as evidenced by Mortgagor's promissory note of even date herewith, which note a provision for escalation of interest rate (paragraphs 9 and 10) of this mortgage provides for an escalation of interest rate under certain conditions), said note to be repaid with interest at the rate or rates therein specified in installments of ONE HUNDRED

FIFTY EIGHT AND 35/100 ----- (\$ 158.35) Dollars each on the first day of each month hereafter, in advance, until the principal sum with interest has been paid in full, such payments to be applied first to the payment of interest, computed monthly on unpaid principal balances, and then to the payment of principal with the last payment, if not sooner paid, to be due and payable TEN years after date, and

WHEREAS, said note further provides that if at any time any portion of the principal or interest due thereunder shall be past due and unpaid for a period of thirty days, or if there shall be any failure to comply with and abide by any By-Laws or the Charter of the Mortgagee, or any stipulations set out in this mortgage, the whole amount due thereunder shall at the option of the holder thereof become immediately due and payable, and such holder shall have the right to institute any proceedings upon said note and any collateral given to secure same, for the purpose of collecting said principal due, and interest, with costs and expenses for proceedings, and



NOW, KNOW ALL MEN, That the Mortgagor, in consideration of said debt and to secure the payment thereof and any further sums which may be advanced by the Mortgagee to the Mortgagor's account, and also in consideration of the sum of Three Dollars (\$3.00) to the Mortgagee in hand well and truly paid by the Mortgagor at and before the sealing of these presents, the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged, has granted, has, caused, will, and released, and by these presents does grant, bargain, sell and release unto the Mortgagee, its successors and assigns, the following described real estate:

All that certain piece, parcel, or lot of land, with all improvements thereon, or hereafter to be constructed thereon, situate, lying and being in the State of South Carolina, County of Greenville, on the southwestern side of Ivy Drive, near Mauldin, being known and designated as Lot No. 38 on a Plat of Greenbrier, recorded in Plat Book 44 at page 65, and described as follows:

BEGINNING at an iron pin on the southwestern side of Ivy Drive, joint front corner of Lots No. 37 and 39, and running thence with the line of Lot No. 37, S. 53-40 W., 200 feet to an iron pin; thence N. 36-20 W., 100 feet to rear corner of Lot No. 39; thence with the line of Lot No. 39, N. 53-40 E., 200 feet to an iron pin on Ivy Drive; thence with the southwestern side of Ivy Drive, S. 36-20 E., 100 feet to the point of beginning.
