C., (hereinafter referred to as Mortgagee) as evidenced by the Mortgagor's promissory note of even date herewith, the terms of which are incorporated herein by reference, in the sum of **Thirteen Thousand Five Hundred and no/100** DOLLARS (\$ 13,500.00), with interest thereon from date at the rate of six (6%) per centum per annum, said principal and interest to be paid as therein stated, and
