Darby, Jr. and John Cottrhan Company, Inc. in consideration of the said debt and sum of money aforesaid, and for the better securing the payment thereof, according to the terms of the said note, and also in consideration of the further sum of Three Dollars, to us in hand well and truly paid at and before the sealing and delivery of these presents, the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged, have granted, bargained, sold and released, and by these presents do grant, bargain, sell and release unto the said Sarah G. Mills, Robert William Bowman and Waco F. Childers, Jr., Inc., their heirs, successors and assigns,

ALL that certain piece, parcel, lot, or tract of land, situate, lying and being in the County of Greenville, State of South Carolina, and being shown on a plat of property prepared for John C. Cottrhan Company, Inc., Ellis L. Darby, Jr., and M. Graham Proffitt, III, by C. O. Riddle Surveying Company, June 23, 1981, and which said plat is recorded in the R. M. C.
