Automotive petroleum products	Used motor oil, filters, bottles, etc.	Limit five gallons.	Convenience Centers and Twin Chimneys Landfill. (Gas only at Blackberry Valley)	Over five gallons - Farm Oil Tank at Twin Chimneys Landfill and O'Neal Residential Waste and Recycling Center
Lead-acid Batteries	Used automotive, marine, lawn mower	Place in container provided	Convenience Centers and Twin Chimneys Landfill	
Cardboard	Corrugated cardboard	Flatten	Convenience Centers, Twin Chimneys Landfill, curbside and drop-off sites	Cardboard with wax finish
Cooking Oil		Place in container provided	Convenience Centers and Twin Chimneys Landfill	
E-Waste	Computers, monitors, keyboards, printers, TV's	Place in trailer provided	Convenience Centers and Twin Chimneys Landfill (except Piedmont & Echo Valley locations)	Residents Only. Businesses must use Twin Chimneys Landfill.

Light Bulbs	All Types	Ask Attendant	Convenience Centers and Twin Chimneys Landfill	Residents Only
Paper	Any paper	Do not tie or bag newspapers.	Convenience Centers, Twin Chimneys Landfill, curbside and drop-off sites	
Plastic Bottles and Jugs	#1 and #2 plastic bottles and jugs with a neck	Rinse, then flatten	Convenience Centers, Twin Chimneys Landfill, curbside and drop-off sites	No diapers, plastic grocery bags, flower pots, I.V. bags, medical tubing
Tires	Passenger vehicle tires	Ask Attendant	Twin Chimneys Landfill (preferred), Convenience Centers and curbside	Commercial vehicles, racing tires and tractor tires. Curbside - Fountain Inn and Travelers Rest
Yard Debris	Tree limbs, leaves, grass clippings, etc.	Do not bag	Twin Chimneys Landfill (preferred), Convenience Centers and curbside	Tree limbs cannot exceed 6' in length or 6" in diameter

Residential Waste & Recycling Centers:

Open 7 a.m. – 6 p.m., Tuesday – Saturday; closed Sunday, Monday and holidays.

Twin Chimneys Landfill:

Open 7:30 a.m. – 4:30 p.m. Monday – Friday; 8 a.m. – 4 p.m., Saturday; and closed Sundays and holidays.

Non-staffed drop-off sites: Open 24 hours.



Other Important Facts

Residential waste is accepted from citizens free of charge at the Twin Chimneys Landfill and all Residential Waste and Recycling Centers. Limit of 3 cubic yards per vehicle per day at Residential Waste and Recycling Centers.

Construction and demolition debris and dead animals must be taken to Twin Chimneys Landfill. Applicable charges will apply. A credit system is available for commercial accounts.

- □ Large quantities of liquid waste and/or hazardous materials ARE NOT accepted by Greenville County. Please call 243-9672 for more information.
- Tires: All large truck, race car and tractor tires MUST be taken to the landfill.
- Proof of residence is required for admittance to all Solid Waste Division facilities.
- □ Free mulch is available at the Twin Chimneys Landfill. Vehicles loaded free of charge 9am-noon, 1pm 3pm Thursday-Saturday. 1/2 Scoop (1.5 cubic yards) free, \$15 for additional 3 cubic yards.
- □ For information about regulations, separation of wastes, penalties, and control and disposal of wastes, contact the Solid Waste Division at (864) 243-9672.
- All materials, including recyclables, left outside of the recycling bins will be considered litter.
- Littering and illegal dumping should be reported to the Greenville County Litter Prevention Coordinator at (864) 467-7289. To report a litterbug call PalmettoPride's Litter Busters hot line at 1-877-7-LITTER. To get involved in litter clean-up or to Adopt-A-Road call (864) 467-7289.
- Paint: Paint must be solidified before disposal. Please use cat litter, oil dry or sand to solidify the paint to be accepted for disposal.
